The Faculty of the History and Philosophy of Medicine and Pharmacy of the Worshipful Society of Apothecaries of London is holding a three day course in the History of Medicine for library and archive staff, museum curators and others working in medical/healthcare institutions. Its aim is to provide a broad framework on the subject to assist those working in the historical medical field or who are responsible for collections but do not have a medical or historical background. Others who wish to increase their knowledge of the subject will be most welcome.

The course will be held on 1st – 3rd February 2012 at Apothecaries' Hall, Black Friars Lane, London EC4V 6EJ. The programme will cover Ancient, Classical, Eastern and Western medicine, and the development of modern medicine from its early roots through to the present world, looking at surgery, war, diagnosis, general practice, hospitals, public health etc. The course will include 15 speakers, three plenary discussion sessions, a guided tour of Apothecaries' Hall and an evening drinks reception.

The cost of this course will be £170 for 3 days, £140 for 2 days and £80 for 1 day
